NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The City of Milton has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 17.37 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at the City of Milton Council Chambers, 2006 Heritage Walk, Milton, Georgia, 30004, on the following dates and times:

August 6, 2018 at 9:00 AM  
August 6, 2018 at 6:00 PM  
August 13, 2018 at 5:45 PM

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 4.731 mills, an increase of 0.700 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 4.031 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$400,000 is approximately \$112.00 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$450,000 is approximately \$126.00.

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EXPLANATION

Your total property tax rate, or millage rate, will remain the same as the previous eleven years at 4.731. The City is estimating a slight increase in property values that may result in additional property tax revenue. Actual changes in property values will not be available until the City receives the official property digest from the Fulton County Tax Commissioner.
