

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILTON, GEORGIA
TO SET QUALIFYING FEES FOR MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS, such Code provides at § 21-2-131(a)(1)(A) that qualifying fees shall be fixed no later than February 1 of any year in which a general election is to be held; and

WHEREAS, State law provides that such fees shall be three percent (3%) of the total gross salary of the office paid in the preceding year of a salaried office, including all supplements authorized by law; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with its Charter, the City of Milton will be holding elections for Council Seats for District 1/Post 2, District 2/Post 2, and District 3/Post 2 in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Internal Revenue Service has held that Councilmembers hold salaried positions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Milton, Georgia, pursuant to their authority do hereby adopt a Resolution as follows:

1.

The following qualifying fees shall apply to candidates seeking municipal office in the election to be held November 5, 2019:

City Councilmember - \$390.00
