Jack helped to install fencing along parking area at Bethwell Community Ctr.



Shredding Event – Cindy. Does MGG want to sponsor a 3 hour shredding event in city hall parking lot? People donate for shredding. yes


Williams Paint recycling - James has had problems being in compliance with EPD, and we need to be careful about working with him.
