Tass Welch called the meeting to order and Ken Woods seconded the motion.

Committee members reviewed and approved the meeting minutes from October 9, 2013.

Old Business:

- MDAC members further discussed the Web Design and Links topic.
- Renee mentioned People First and Benefits Navigator as two potentially good additions to the MDAC website.
- Tass mentioned the Facebook page topic and there was further discussion about creating one for MDAC. Jason (City of Milton) would be able to assist MDAC in creating a Facebook page.
- It was also brought up how connecting an MDAC Facebook page with the Milton Fire Department and Milton Police Department would be a great boost for such a page.
- Linking an MDAC page with other Milton based groups such as Better Together was deemed a good idea as well.
- MDAC discussed the social media policy of Facebook. This policy states that a page cannot promote a private business or non-government agency in any way. No solicitations or endorsements can be made for businesses that fall into those categories.
- MDAC will need to further discuss what kinds of content can and cannot be posted should we create a Facebook page.
- The committee briefly touched on Smart 911 and the Open Records Act and potential questions regarding these two matters.


New Business:

- The open positions of Gary Arnold and Anise Castleberry were discussed.
- Ken Woods made a motion to have Paul fill Gary's position and Tass seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.
- Paul was nominated and accepted the role on MDAC. He planned to be sworn in on Monday, December 2, 2013.
- Renee made a motion that we reappoint Tass Welch to another two-year term on MDAC. Dudley seconded the motion.
- The term for Tass will begin on January 1, 2014 and run through December 31, 2015.
- A second motion was made for Tass to retain the position of MDAC Chair. The motion was made by Renee and seconded by Dudley.
- Both motions were passed by unanimous vote.
- MDAC then further discussed filling the position of Anise Castleberry. Tass mentioned that Melinda Ross is interested, but possibly too busy at the current time.
- Renee also mentioned a person in the Milton area who might also be a good possibility.

- The committee briefly touched on the CAD system in Milton and how it can be helpful in rescuing people and animals in emergency situations.

Tass Welch moved to adjourn the meeting. Renee Catanzaro seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous to adjourn. The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, December 11, 2013.
