Constitution Week 2018



WHEREAS, The Constitution of the United States, the guardian of our liberties, is a product of reflection and choice, embodying the principles of limited government in a Republic dedicated to rule by law, not by men; and

WHEREAS, September 17, 2018 marks the two hundred and thirty first anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic exercises that will commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915, guarantees the issue of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17th through September 23rd as Constitution Week.

This Constitution Week, we, the City of Milton, urge all citizens to study the Constitution and to express gratitude for the privilege of American citizenship in our Republic, functioning under the superb body of laws - the Constitution of the United States of America.

Now, therefore, we, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Milton, proclaim the week of September 17, 2018 through September 23, 2018 as Constitution Week in the City of Milton and ask our citizens to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787.
